Please check off all similar supplies you already have, and feel free to bring any acrylic supplies you have to class. We will go over this list the first class.

<u>Paint</u>

Recommended Paints:

- Cadmium Red Medium Hue (37ml tube)
- Alizarin Crimson (37ml tubes)
- Cadmium Yellow Medium (37ml tubes)
- Cadmium Yellow light (37ml tubes)
- Phthalo Blue (37ml tubes)
- French Ultramarine blue (37ml tubes)
- Sap Green (37ml tubes)
- Viridian Green -sometimes just called Viridian (37ml tubes)
- Burnt Umber (37ml tubes)
- Yellow ochre (37ml tubes)
- Titanium White (will need larger 150 ml tube)

Optional Paints:

- Indian Yellow
- Quinacridone Red
- Quinacridone Rose
- Cerulean blue
- Mediterranean Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Burnt sienna
- Raw sienna
- Raw Umber







Brushes

- Natural Bristle Paint Brushes:
 - #6 #1 Round
 - #8 #2 Flat
 - #2 Filbert
 - #1 Bright
- Synthetic or Sable Paint Brushes:
 - #6 Round
 - #4 Flat
 - #2 Bright
 - #2/0 Round

Canvas/Paper

- Canvas pad (any size you like)
- Canvas 24"x 18"

General Supplies

- Paint box or tool box to hold your supplies
- 2 plastic or glass containers for your water
- Paper pallette
- Palette knife (metal)
- Cotton rags and or paper towels
- Gloss medium
- Fluid medium
- Spray bottle
- Soap to clean brushes
- Retarder
