Please feel free to bring similar supplies you already have rather than buying new supplies. We will go over this list in the first class and I will have supplies that you can use in the first class if you are uncertain of what exactly to buy.

Drawing Materials

- Newsprint Pad: 18" x 24"
- Vine Charcoal: Soft
- Charcoal Pencil: 4B or 6B
- Artist Chamois

Paint

Recommended Paints:

- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Transparent Yellow (Winsor & Newton brand)
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Permanent Alizarin Crimson
- Ultramarine Blue
- Titanium White

Brushes

Recommended Brushes:

- Natural Bristle Filbert or Flat Brushes: Size 10, 8, 6
- Nylon Synthetic Bright Brushes: Size 4, 2, 0

Painting Surface

- Canvas Boards (2): 8" x 10"
- Stretched Canvas (1): 18" x 24"







General Supplies

- Paper Towels or Rags: Smooth paper towels (Viva brand recommended)
- Palette Knife: Metal with a gooseneck (not plastic)
- Palette: Grey tone disposable paper palette
- Turpenoid or Gamsol: 4 ounce size
- Linseed Oil: Cold pressed
- Glass Jar with Lid: Small size (like a baby food jar)
- Ivory Soap: 1 bar (to clean brushes)
